





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

Phonics Information Evening for Parents/Carers

We would like to welcome our Reception and Key Stage One parents and carers to our Phonics and Early Reading Event next Wednesday 28th February at 3pm, in the school hall, to find out all about our Read Write Inc Phonics programme we use at St Philip's and learn strategies to support your child and their reading at home. We will have examples of resources and activities set up for you to see, along with some activities you can try with your child. Our Year One children are currently preparing for their Phonics Screening Statutory Assessment, and during this session we will be we will be sharing some information on how to support your child to prepare for this. We will also have some resources for you to take away and use at home. The session will be around 30- 45 minutes which will include a short presentation and an opportunity to talk to some of the Read Write Inc Teachers, ask any questions you may have, and trial some of the activities available with your child. 
Parent's Evening
